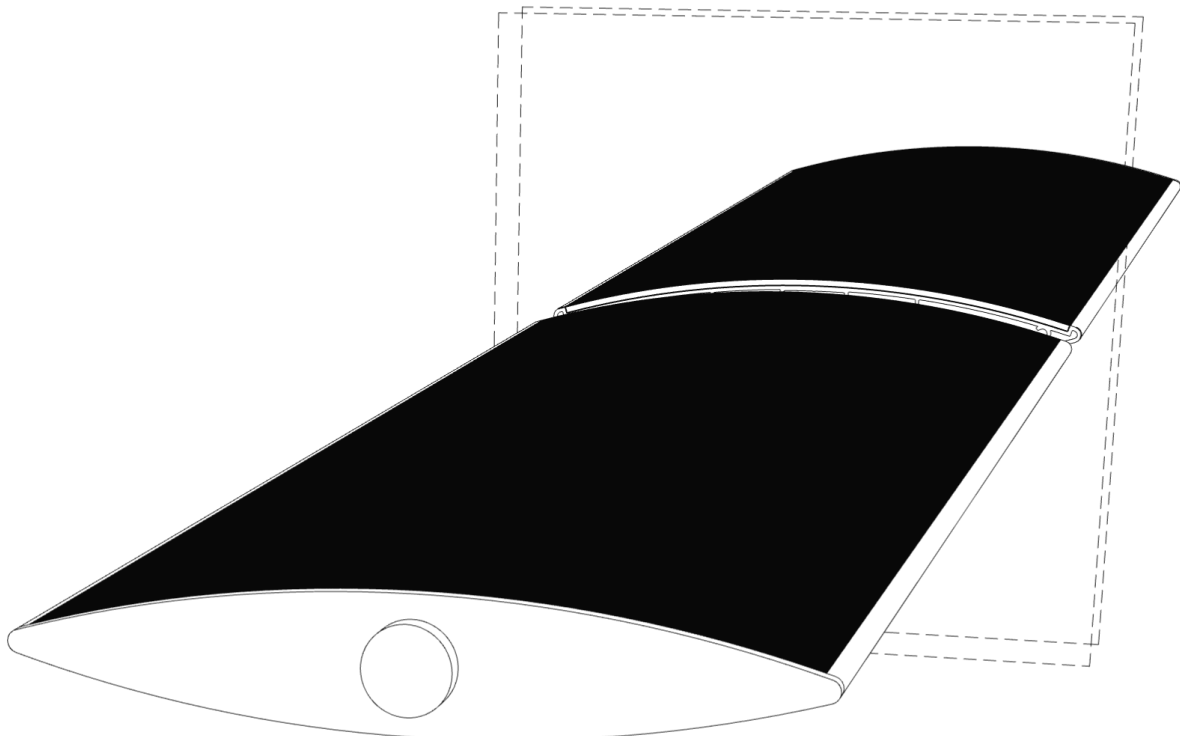
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a blade for a solar shade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a blade for a solar shade, showing our new design;

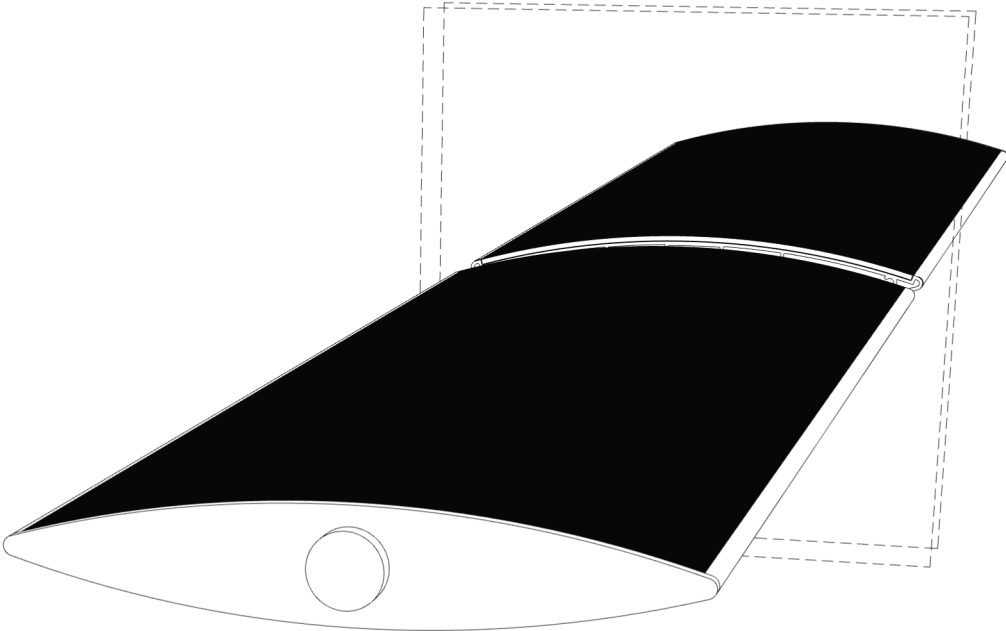

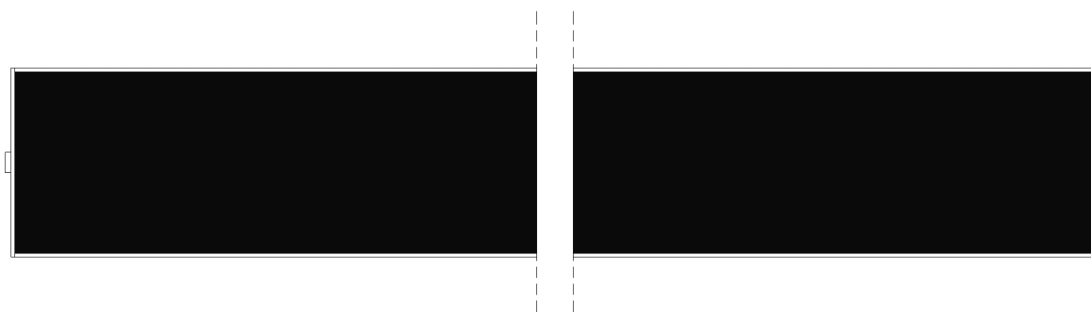

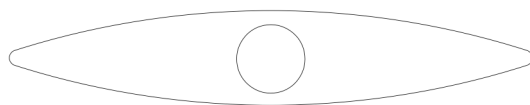

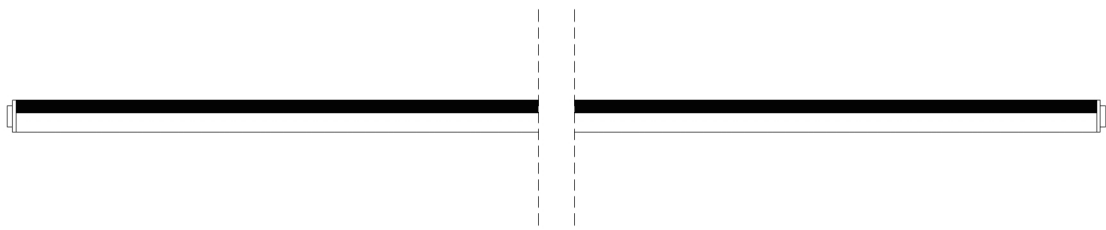

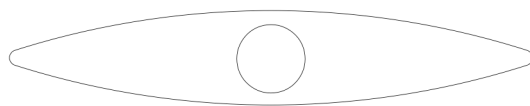
